Does your group involve younger volunteers?

Be Collective have recently updated their terms, and now volunteers age 14+ can create their own account on Be Collective (preiously they had to be age 16+ to have their own account). Individuals no longer need to include a date of birth unless the organisation asks for it. This means that it is only volunteers aged 13 and under who need to be part of a family group to register for opportunities.

Have you checked your information on Be Collective?

It's good practice to routinely check your details are all correct on the Be Collective platform.



- Are you approaching the closing date for your opportunity and need to extend it?
- Have you uploaded a logo and header image? This will help with the algorithim on Be Collective and can make your opportunities more visible.
- Is the contact person for your opportunities still correct?
- Have you given people enough time to apply for your opportunity? don't have your closing date too tight!

And don't forget to share your opportunities with Volunteer Now - they will then show on the opportunity search on our website as well as on the Be Collective platform (all volunteer registrations will still come to you via Be Collective).

Volunteer Friendly will be a key award and development tool in the quality pipeline. Volunteer Friendly is based on the national UK standard Investing in Volunteers (liV), designed for small groups/organisations who may not be ready to undertake liV.
