RSBP - Give Corncrake a Home Project (Various Locations) We need your help to dig up and wash nettle rhizomes at various sites in Northern Ireland. These rhizomes are used to create essential habitat for Corncrake on Rathlin Island, their only known breeding site. No experience of digging needed, everything is explained and demonstrated. As this work takes place outside in the autumn/winter months warm layers, waterproof clothing and suitable footwear are essential. So come and join a dedicated team of RSPB staff and regular volunteers, learn more about 'Give Corncrake a Home' project, meet new people, gain experience in conservation, and have lots of "Crex" (Corncrake lingo) in the process!
