Volunteer Drivers – Cancer Focus (Newcastle)



Our volunteer drivers provide essential transport for cancer patients to and from their appointments, helping to take away that stress and worry. Appointments will usually take place Monday - Friday during normal office hours but we are sometimes asked to provide transport outside of these hours. Conservation Officer Red Kite Field Surveyor – RSPB (Co. Down)



In spring and summer, you will be monitoring nests of red kites to assess the success of breeding pairs and fledglings. In winter you will be watching roosts at sunset and identifying wing tags to help monitor the progress of the population after their reintroduction. You will be deployed in various locations to investigate red kite sightings and identify new nesting and roosting sites within rural communities in South Down, from Ballynahinch to Downpatrick, Newcastle and more. <https://tinyurl.com/jw8zajxp>

Volunteer Caseworker – SSAFA (Co. Down)



Would you like to support people who have served in the Armed Forces? You don't need a military background, just the ability to listen, some basic I.T skills and good written and spoken English. If so, this could be the role for you. Caseworkers work with clients to figure out what type of help they need. Next, they find the right sources of support and arrange for clients to access it. This might be funds for special equipment for someone with a disability, adaptations to a property so an older client can remain at home or funds for a rental deposit.
