Do you advertise roles suitable for younger volunteers?

If so, you need to ensure you have **verified group status**. This is a requirement for engaging young people in volunteering through Be Collective. Without verification, young people (under the age of 18) using the platform will not be able to either see nor apply for your youth accessible opportunities!



Not verified? No problem. It's easy to submit a form and any group can do it (Standard, Plus and Pro). Find out more in these help articles:

Have you checked your information on Be Collective?

It's good practice to routinely check your details are all correct on the Be Collective platform.

- Are you approaching the closing date for your opportunity and need to extend it?
- Have you uploaded a logo and header image? This will help with the algorithm on Be Collective and can make your opportunities more visible.
- Is the contact person for your opportunities still correct?
- Have you given people enough time to apply for your opportunity? *don't have your closing date too tight!*

And don't forget to share your opportunities with Volunteer Now - they will then show on the opportunity search on our website as well as on the Be Collective platform (all volunteer registrations will still come to you via Be Collective).

Volunteer Friendly will be a key award and development tool in the quality pipeline. Volunteer Friendly is based on the national UK standard Investing in Volunteers (liV), designed for small groups/organisations who may not be ready to undertake liV.


